Senior Selections

We reached out to our seniors during second quarter regarding a senior selection for the show. If you did not respond to that email, or you didn’t hear from us and you have a senior interested in performing a special piece in our show, please email the studio asap. We will be sending information home with our seniors in the next week or two regarding special details for the show as it’s time to reserve studio space for rehearsals and coordinate assistance with choreography. We also need to select costumes and cut music for these pieces.

*Costumes

Invoices will be sent via email from QuickBooks just like tuition invoices; however, we will accept credit card payments for costumes. Invoices will start going out as soon as we have all of the costumes and accessories ordered. You can expect to receive one invoice per household; however, it might be necessary for us to

split invoices by dancer.

Please pay attending to costume description details. The details will also help you confirm which accessories and tights go with which costume. Your prompt payment is appreciated. If there are any questions or concerns regarding costumes, please let us know.
